



NU370 Nursing Leadership

May 12th-26th, 2018



Spend two weeks learning nursing leadership principles and critical issues facing the nursing profession, which are integral to the provision of health care individuals, families, communities, and global health. This 3 credit course is offered to rising senior nursing students to fulfill a required major course. Students will participate in a collaborative class session with 4th year Irish nursing students, complete 8 hours of clinical observation in an Irish hospital or community clinic with an Irish nurse preceptor, and partake in local field experiences. Enjoy group dinners at a variety of local pubs, excursions to see surrounding archeological sites, an overnight trip to beautiful Killarney, a day trip to the Blasket Islands, and more. Due to the clinical component, early pre-acceptance is required by submitting a letter of intent for participation in the course and acknowledgement of associated fees required in December. If selected, a MRSA screening before the start of Spring semester (January) is required.
